



Reconditioning checklist, rollator

Volaris rollators are intended to be reused throughout their expected service life (7 years).

Cleaning

Clean in a washing cabinet at 60° for 45min with the brakes disengaged. The rollator must be allowed to cool to room temperature before being adjusted and used. Manual cleaning using a high pressure washer, water hose, cloths impregnated with a mild detergent with a pH value of 7-12, e.g. soap solution, or appropriate non-abrasive cleaning cloths. Surface disinfectant of an approved grade may be used. Let the disinfectant sit for 1–5 minutes and leave to air dry.
